Here are a few of Imke's achievements for 2017.

- Imke started full time dancing this year at Canterbury Ballet where she also does part time school. You have to be selected and do a audition.
- Imke won all of her dances at the Follow your dreams dance comp in Aug 2016 and also the Junior champ title & qualified for Nationals in Melbourne Jan 2017. She competed there and got top 3 in all her dances in big classes and managed to win the Lyrical section against 27 other overseas dancers.
- While in Melbourne, Imke danced in the Maddie & Mackenzie Ziegler Australian tour where she was announced as the Melbourne state winner.
- She competed in various local & outside Christchurch dance comps and achieved great results in all. (1sts, 2nds, 3rds and other placings.)
- Imke competed in the Dance NZ Made school competition where she had to do a self choreographed dance. She won the year 9 section and also qualified for the Nationals in Palmerston North. Unfortunately she could not go.
- Most recently, Imke danced in the Centre Stage talent comp 27/10/17 where she won and received a 3 hour recording prize and \$1000.

Hey Chch dance lovers!

I am currently in Germany, doing the last bits and pieces of moving preparation and goodbyes before using my one-way ticket back to the homeland! Amongst all the stress of moving continents, I have taken time to reflect on the past decade of adventure, performances and wealth of dance knowledge which I have accumulated throughout these crazy awesome years in Europe, and I have every intention of sharing all that I can with the future dance generation in Christchurch.

My career highlights were performing with Dutch musician /actor/writer Herman Van Veen, learning from him reminded me a lot of Sir Russel Kerr - his creativity, work ethic and humble way of producing incredible pieces was inspiring. From there I went on to work with many different Fusion dance companies - De Kiss Moves and Massive Movement being the 2 companies where I feel like I grew the most as an artist, developing my choreography skills and pushing the boundaries of what dance meant for me. Touring Europe with these companies and teaching workshops in primary/high schools all over The Netherlands enabled me to discover my strengths in learning different languages too; a skill which I am pretty proud of! After 5 years in the Netherlands though, I felt like it was time for a change and after a round of auditions in Germany I ended up being cast as a lead dancer with Apassionata -Europes biggest horse show, touring for 8 months of the year and performing in stadiums with up to 14,000 people! The struggle of dancing physically tough choreographies on the sand, and staying out of the way of 50 horses was all worth it to feel like a superstar with those huge audiences 5x a week. Apassionata was also where I met Mel - who was working as a makeup artist, dresser and wig/headpiece maker. We quickly became partners and after 3 years touring Europe with her, we lived in Berlin together - which leads me on to my final career highlight; Stars in Concert - the longest running (20 years) and most successful show in German history. It was a career highlight for me because it is the job where I had the most fun. Every day, on stage and off stage was pure joy and it taught me so much about creating positive working environments; something which I endeavour to do in Christchurch too! So Mel and I are excited to be arriving soon in Christchurch, with plans to open Flow Dance Academy in Term 1 2018 - Mel recently graduated from a yoga teacher course in Berlin so she is looking forward to putting all that fresh knowledge into practice (and English!) this summer. I am thankful for the support of the Chch Ballet Society Committee and members from afar and I am looking forward to reconnecting with you all soon.

NEW PROGRAMME STARTING IN FEB 2018 Developing Dancers Programme

Our DDP programme is for classical ballet & contemporary students aged 11yrs and up who wish to attend 2 specialised coaching and mentoring sessions per week after school in addition to their normal training. The focus will be on refining classical technique, artistry, Porte de bra & pure alignment, strength & conditioning programmes and an open contemporary coaching class. One session will consist of a 2hr open classical technique class and the second session will offer a 1hr strengthening & conditioning programme & a 1hr open contemporary coaching class.

The sessions will be held weekly on a Weds & Friday 3.30-5.30 during the school term
